

## Session One: Celebrate



### ***Sunday is a Party, and we're always expecting guests.***

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## Discussion



1. Think about some of the major celebrations you've had throughout your life. Birthdays, weddings, Christmases, graduation parties, retirement parties, etc. Describe one of those memorable celebrations and what it meant to you.
2. Celebrate. What does that look like to you? How do you celebrate Jesus in your life?
3. Anthony mentioned that we want you to join the celebration at your own pace, come as you are, imperfection is required. Is this important to you?
4. The definition of celebrate is this:
  - a. To acknowledge, a significant or happy day or event, with a social gathering or enjoyable activity.
  - b. To honor, praise publicly
    - i. ***Does this idea of church being a celebration change your perspective on what church looks like? Anthony describes it as a feast vs. a funeral.***
5. There's two sides of celebrating:
  - a. A public side - Gathering together on Sundays and celebrating what God is doing..
  - b. A personal side - Celebrate daily on your own through prayer and scripture
